School Immunizations

Dear Parents/Guardians,

The foll owing is an update for rou tine school immunizations. To ensure the effective roll-out of the COVID-19 vaccine, adjustments to other immunization services have been needed over the past year. Immunization of students in grade six, seven and nine has continue d to proceed, though some delays may have occurred in some cases. Alberta Health Services (AHS) will continue to provide school immunization services at the earliest opportunity and will ensure that every eligible student has access to vaccines for which they have received consent for. The signed consent on file from parents or guardians will be used. It may take more than 1 school year for your child to get all the doses of each vaccine.

A HS recommends that Albertans 12+ are immunized with COV ID-19 vaccine. It is recommended that you wait at least 28 days after you have a dose of COV ID-19 vaccine before you get an other vaccine. If you've had an other vaccine, wait 14 days before you get a COV ID-a9 vaccine. For vaccine information please visit: <u>COVID-19 vaccines</u>
