If your child does not celebrate Halloween, please share this information with your child's homeroom teacher prior to Oct 31, so alternate plans can be arranged for your child while they attend school. COSTUMES:

STUDENTS ARE INVITED TO DRESS UP ON THURSDAY, OCTOBER 31ST. WE ASK THAT STUDENTS ARRIVE AT SCHOOL <u>ALREADY DRESSED IN THE "BASE" OF THEIR COSTUMES FOR THE DAY OR THAT THE</u> <u>COSTUMES BE EASILY PUT ON WITHOUT CHANGING,</u> AS THERE WILL BE VERY LITTLE OPPORTUNITY TO CHANGE IN THE WASHROOMS.

PLEASE ENSURE YOUR CHILD'S COSTUME IN KINDERGARTEN - GR 9 MEETS THESE REQUIREMENTS:

- All full face covering costumes must be removable, not permitted in the Hallways or outside, and must be removed if a teacher asks.
- <u>NO REAL WEAPONS OR TOY WEAPONS</u> INCLUDING GUNS, KNIVES, SWORDS, BATONS, ETC

FOOD/TREATS/CANDY:

You may send an additional special treat for your own child in their lunch box. Specific Homeroom Teachers may have a plan for treats during their in class Halloween Party and will reach out to families. Students should not bring extra candies or treats to be shared on the 31st without prior planning with the Classroom teachers.

CLASSROOM TEACHERS MAY ALSO ASK FOR ADDITIONAL ADULTS TO ASSIST WITH PARTIES (SPECIFIC CLASSES SUCH AS KINDERGARTEN OR OTHER EARLY YEARS MAY HAVE SUPPORT AND WILL REACH OUT TO FAMILIES). LARGE PIECES OF COSTUMES (CLOAKS, WINGS, HEAD GEAR, ETC) CAN BE BROUGHT TO SCHOOL AND PUT ON LATER. <u>SPECIALTY MAKEUP SHOULD BE APPLIED PRIOR TO SCHOOL AS THERE</u> MAY BE LIMITED TIME IN THE BATHROOMS AT LUNCH, OR PLEASE CONNECT WITH YOUR CHILD'S

HOMEROOM TEACHER.

We would like you to consider simple costumes that can be worn at school the whole day. Please <u>do not send any small or large accessories</u> (i.e. headpieces, wands, or other items that can be easily lost) Alternative to wearing a costume, students could choose to wear Halloween themed or coloured clothing.
